Welcome to the Pella Soccer Club!

The following is general information regarding our registration process:

- The spring season runs from late March to late May/early June and contains eight scheduled league games. There are no league games scheduled for Memorial Day weekend.
- Players new to the club **MUST** provide us with a photocopy of a government issued birth certification, passport, etc. as legal proof of age before being placed on a team. **Please note that hospital, baptismal or religious certificates will not be accepted.** Your registration will not be processed without proof of age.
- Effort is made to keep recreational teams together from season to season, if possible, however there is no guarantee this will happen. The number of players registered for each age bracket and gender dictates team formation. Players who register late (after 12/31/09) forfeit their priority placement on the team they played on in the previous season and **WILL NOT** be guaranteed a spot on that team. If a player sat out a season that also forfeits his/her spot on the team he/she played on in the past.
- The club's goal is to allow as many players as possible the opportunity to play soccer. Teams are formed based on the ages and the number of players as well as the ability to find coaches. Team membership is not guaranteed!
- There are situations that arise where a player may be asked to play in an older age bracket. This would be done only to allow the player on a roster or to allow another player on a roster. Players can only play up one older age bracket. There is no guarantee they would stay with this team in future seasons.
- Teams are either female or co-ed. There is no "male only" designation. Boys are assigned to the co-ed teams. There are times when it is necessary to assign female players to co-ed teams comprised mostly of male players. Female players assigned to a co-ed team would stay in their own age bracket. There is no guarantee they would stay with this team in future seasons.
- It is recommended that each player bring a ball to practices. A size 3 ball should be used for U8 players, size 4 for U10 to U12 players, and size 5 for U13 and above.

Uniforms: All players must wear the new Pella Soccer Club uniform, club socks and shin-guards. Uniforms are new for spring 2010. Sizing and socks are available at Sports Page Sporting Goods. Payment plans are available.

Parental Volunteer Support: Your help is needed! Pella Soccer Club is Pella's only regulation soccer program serving over 400 players and we exist through volunteer efforts. Parents/guardians are asked to volunteer a small amount of time to the club on behalf of each child. Please check on of the opportunities shown on the registration form to specify where you would prefer to help. Duties will be assigned if no area is checked. In 2010, concession stand volunteers will no longer be assigned by team but will be assigned by the concession stand manager. You will be emailed your assigned date(s) and time(s). If your assigned dates do not work, you are responsible to trade with another volunteer. Please note we must rely on our volunteers and failure to show up to an assigned duty will result in a \$20 charge. If you do not wish to volunteer, a fee of \$25 per player will be accepted in lieu of volunteer time.

Photography Release: In the Pella Soccer Club, photographs or likenesses may be released without written consent unless the parent/guardian provides the club with written notification that they object to this policy. This written notification must be submitted along with the registration form and must include the player's name and address.

The Pella Soccer Club is committed to age-appropriate skill development. It is the club's goal to provide children the opportunity to enjoy and learn the game of soccer at the level they desire.

Dear PSC parents,

The PSC board has approved a new uniform which will be used starting spring 2010. The primary reason for this change is in response to referee comments about our kids not having matching uniforms which is due to manufacturers switching designs every few years.

Our new uniforms will always be available because they are laser dye injected (sublimated). They have a unique design which will get rid of the need to have that white T-shirt in your player's gear bag for jersey conflicts at away games. They will also incorporate the color orange into our uniform, as well as our logo on the jersey and shorts. The only players exempt from the new uniform are any current high school players, as they only play one season.

The new kit will be \$70 plus socks. All non-premier teams should already be using the PSC sock available at Sports Page. If not, that should be implemented across the board for the spring season.

We realize that this uniform is more expensive and have implemented some solutions. **For the spring 2010 season, the soccer club will contribute \$25 toward the cost of one uniform per player, thus reducing the out-of-pocket cost to \$45.00.** This benefit is being offered for this season due to the current economic conditions and to help reduce the impact of this transition.

In addition, the board is working to implement several programs related to the new uniforms. We will be starting a exchange program – if your player outgrows the uniform, stops playing soccer, or graduates; those uniforms can then be sold to other players in need of a larger uniform or to a new player. Additionally, we will be having a club wide fund raiser in the spring with funds raised going towards the uniform cost.

We will need to have your player's size before the first of the year in order to get the uniforms made. Please visit Sports Page to try on the new uniform for sizing as soon as possible.
